Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome back. We hope you all had a lovely half term break.

We were delighted to hear the Prime Minister's announcement this week and look forward to welcoming all children back on Monday 8th March 2021. It is vital that we continue to follow very strict safety measures to keep staff, children and families safe and avoid any future closures.

We have reviewed our risk assessment and implemented some enhanced safety measures. Please read the information carefully to ensure all parents, staff and children are following the procedures from Monday 8th March.





We will continue to follow the Department of Education and Public Health guidance.

Bubbles

We have created four bubbles: Wrens & Bluebell Nursery Robins House Martins Kestrels

Bubbles have a consistent team of staff and do not mix.

Preparing for the school day.

- Please do not send in any school bags or book bags.
- Please provide a disposable bag for packed lunches.
- Please provide a water bottle.

Face Coverings

All parents are expected to wear face coverings at all times. Staff will wear face coverings in school where social distancing with children is not possible. All staff wear face coverings in communal areas.

Uniform

Full school uniform will be expected from Monday 8th March. On PE days (See PE section) children to come to school wearing their PE kits please.

Drop Off

We will implement a staggered start and end to the school day to reduce the number of people on the premises and avoid any contacts with people outside your family bubble.

8:40-8:50am- All families with a surname starting with the letter **A-J** can enter the yard and drop off children. Teachers and teaching assistants will be on the yard to welcome children and supervise them walking to classes.

8:55-9:05am- Families with surnames starting with the letter **K-Z** can enter the yard and drop off children.

Please do not arrive at school before your allocated time. It is vital we reduce the contact between families as we remain in a national lockdown. Please keep a 2 meter distance from other families at all times.

Wrens & Bluebell Nursery- Please use the reception class door.

Robins- Please use the side gate.

House Martins- Please use the gate.

Kestrels- Please use the side gate and access the class via the external door.

Collection Times

Children will be dismissed according to their surname.

3:00-3:10pm- A-J 3:15pm-3:25pm- K-Z

Please only arrive at the allocated time. Please come on the yard to collect and keep footpaths clear at all times.

Hand washing

All children will wash hands as they enter school and at regular times throughout the day.

Lunch

Children can choose between a hot cooked school dinner and a packed lunch; packed lunches need to be in disposable bags please. Children will eat their meals in their classrooms to avoid any mixing of bubbles around school.

Snack

Children in Wrens, Bluebell Nursery and Robins receive a free piece of fruit daily. KS2 children can buy a bagel and cuplet of juice for 65p from the school kitchen. Please make all payments using the online payment system and book and pay the day before.
