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# Cheshire West and Chester- Cost of living support

It is currently a really challenging time for a number of families across west Cheshire. Families may be worried about the rising cost of energy bills, food, and transport. The cost of living is rising, and this could have an impact on all aspects of finances. Families may want help accessing welfare rights, benefits and debt advice, support getting all the money they're entitled to, or simply want to know more about national recent support measures.

Whatever their money worries may be, the Council has put together some useful information to help.

The page includes a wealth of information including the Household Support Fund, the Council's HELP Scheme, Warm Welcoming Spaces and much more.

#### Free School Meals Do you qualify?

You may be able to claim free school meals. All key stage one pupils will automatically receive them. You need to apply to Cheshire West and Chester if you are receiving one of the benefits listed below as your school can claim additional funding which can help towards equipment and resources.

We encourage all parents, including KS1 parents, to apply if you think you may be eligible. If you meet the criteria, the school will receive additional funding, called pupil premium, which can be used to support the cost of trips, residential visits and additional support in school.

You will qualify if you are receiving one of the following benefits.

- Income Support
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit but not Working Tax Credit and have an annual income that does not exceed  $\pounds 16,190$
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

#### Do you receive Working Tax credit?

If you or a partner receive Working Tax Credit regardless of income you will not qualify for free school meals.
