Our school is full of happy, laughing children who have settled back in very quickly and are thoroughly enjoying being back in class with their friends and teachers. It is more important than ever that we continue to follow the lockdown rules and hope more restrictions will be lifted in the coming weeks.

### Lateral Flow Rapid Testing

Households, support and childcare bubbles, of children at nursery, primary and secondary schools and colleges, can now get regular rapid COVID19 testing. Please follow the link for further information on our school website: <u>http://www.tilston.cheshire.sch.uk/page/asymptomatic-testing/99839</u>

Staff have been doing this for some time now, testing ourselves every Monday and Thursday morning before school, in order to offer the greatest protection we can for our children and for each other. I think it would be really good if all of our families would do this too. It is very simple to do and is a great way to look after one another. If a member of staff or child displays Covid symptoms, they still need to selfisolate immediately and book a PCR test. Lateral flow tests are not to be used when a person displays symptoms.

### Symptoms

Public Health England have provided a list of additional Covid symptoms in children. If your child displays any of the symptoms on the list below, you must book a PCR test immediately and your child must stay at home.

- •Shortness of breath
- Muscle or body aches
- Fatigue
- •Sore throat
- •Headache
- •Nasal congestion or runny nose
- •Diarrhoea
- Nausea or vomiting




