Dear Parents and Carers

Thank you for your continued support and understanding during these uncertain times. This week there has been a significant increase in positive cases in schools across Cheshire West and Chester with some schools having to close because of outbreaks. It is vital we continue to follow all safety measures to keep our staff, children and families safe.

We have received several reports from concerned parents regarding families who are not following the lockdown rules. As I have already said, I am not going to police the situation, but we do all have a moral responsibility to keep our community safe. We are doing everything we can in school to keep your children safe, please do the same and help to protect our staff and children and help to us to keep our school open.

If your child displays any of the symptoms listed below, please do not send them into school and book a PCR test as soon as possible. If a child displays any of the symptoms in school, we will send them home. We appreciate these symptoms are similar to a common cold, but we must remain vigilant and book a PCR test to rule out Covid-19.
