Tilston School Association Treasurer's Report School Year '21/'22

The TSA started the year with a healthy balance of £7,174.14. It has had the most successful period of fundraising in recent years, raising a total of £7,545.78 (after expenses). The Christmas Fair and the Summer Social remain the two most significant events of the year and account for c.70% of the funds raised. The auction of promises, a new event this year, deserves special mention as it raised £1,882.00 alone.

The school lottery has continued to be a reliable fundraiser raising £880.70 this year. This is lower than last year so every effort should be made to promote this within the Tilston School Family.

It should be noted that our finances would not have been as strong this year if it were not for the kind donations of time, gifts and funds from key supporters both inside and outside of the TSA. The likes of the Christmas Raffle, Auction of Promises and Supper with Santa were all subsidised in part, or in full, at no cost to the TSA. I'd personally like to thank those that have donated. Your kindness is recognised and appreciated.

The TSA were pleased to donate £4,304.16 to the school this year. £2,258.38 went directly to investing in the Little Wandle Book scheme, supporting reading for all years. Teaching was further enriched in the continuous development of the EYFS outdoor area and providing glockenspiels for music lessons. As has become a tradition, we provided funding for the Christmas Play and provision of the Leaver's Photo Books.

The balance carried forward totals £10,415.76. It is important for funds raised to be rapidly invested for the benefit of all and investments have already been identified for next year.

It is a legislative necessity for the TSA to now be registered as a charity.

On a personal note, I'd like to thank the TSA team for their support over the past couple of years. It has been a thoroughly enjoyable experience! I would ask that everyone with a connection to the school to consider getting involved and ensure the continuing success of the association.
