Start of the School Day

I appreciate that we are approaching the end of term and some children are finding it a bit trickier to get up in the mornings, however I would like to remind you that the school opens at **8.40 am**. We allow a staggered start to the day and staff provide an early morning task for the children to complete up until registration at **8.55 am**. We find it really helps the children to settle if they arrive in time to complete this activity and then they are ready and alert to start their day. Some families are regularly dashing through the school gates as the register is about to be taken and this does not give the children enough time to get themselves settled and prepared for the day ahead. It is particularly noticeable in the EYFS and Year 1/2 classes at the current time. 
New Arts Festival Launches in May
