Covid 19 Update

The infection rate across Cheshire West and Chester has increased by 400%. It is vital we continue to follow all safety measures to keep staff, children and families safe.

The family member did a LFT test at home after developing symptoms like mild hay fever. They self-isolated immediately after testing positive and booked a PCR. Due to this swift action, all classes can remain open. The new Delta variant is 80% more infectious than other strains. Please be extra vigilant and book a PCR test if your child develops any of the symptoms shared by Public Health.


