Pupil Premium Funding

Attached to this week's newsletter is an application form which may enable your child to benefit from the **Pupil Premium**. This is additional funding given to the school to spend on additional resources and support. Funding is based on children who are registered for what was previously called a 'free school meal'. As you know, children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 currently receive a 'universal' school meal; because of this, some parents who would have previously applied for a free school meal, may miss the opportunity to register for the Pupil Premium. The letter attached explains the criteria used to determine whether or not you qualify for this additional funding. The process is completely confidential and is extremely beneficial in supporting your child. If you have any questions regarding registration, please feel free to have a word with me and I will be happy to help.

Head Lice
