I am delighted to inform you that over the next **Premier**[®] academic year we will be working in partnership with **Premier Sport** to raise the profile of Physical Education and sport within school. Premier Sport will be working alongside staff to deliver

curriculum PE and will be offering lunchtime activities and a range of after school clubs throughout the year.

The after school clubs will take place each week on a **Monday** and **Friday**, from 3.15 to 4.15 pm throughout the term. Both clubs running this half term will be for KS2 pupils; these will be tag rugby on Mondays and Play Active Sport (fun-based games and activities) on Fridays. There will be a small charge of **£1 per session** to cover some of the coaching costs. For our Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children, there will be planned activities running through lunchtime on Mondays. Our Premier Sport clubs will start next week so please return your permission slip straight away if your child would like to take part. Places are limited and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. I am also working with Premier Sport to set up and deliver the Golden Mile in school.
