We want to emphasise the critical importance of excellent attendance for your children's education and overall wellbeing. Regular attendance at primary school sets the foundation for a successful academic journey. It allows children to actively participate in class, engage with their peers, and build essential social skills. Moreover, consistent attendance ensures that your child doesn't miss out on crucial lessons and experiences that are vital for their development. By prioritising attendance, you are not only nurturing their educational growth but also promoting their emotional and social wellbeing.

Holiday Requests

We have received several requests for holidays during term time and I would like to draw your attention to the section below from our Attendance Policy. Whilst I do appreciate the cost of holidays is significantly cheaper during term time, we have to implement the Department of Education's Attendance Guidance.

Leave of Absence

'Parents are requested to arrange their family holidays within the school holidays, rather than in term time. In line with amendments made in the Education Regulations 2013, **Headteachers may not grant any leave of absence during term time unless they are exceptional circumstances.**'

Any parents/ carer wishing to request leave of absence for their son/daughter should complete a request for absence form, available from the school office. Completed forms should be sent for consideration to the Headteacher ahead of any request. All requests will be responded to in writing and returned within 7 days.

It should be noted that if any application is declined and a consecutive five or more unauthorised day's absence occurs, Tilston Primary may apply for a Fixed Penalty Notice. The Penalty Notice is issued individually to each parent/ carer who fail to ensure their children's regular attendance in school by Cheshire West and Chester. The penalty is £60 per parent/ carer, per child if paid within 21 days rising to £120 if paid within 28 days. Non-payment of a Fixed Penalty Notice may result in prosecution in the Magistrates Court. If proved guilty, the parents/ carers will receive a criminal record.

I would like to thank you all for arriving at school before the gates close at 8:50am. We have seen a significant improvement which is reflected in how settled the children are and ready to learn at the start of the day.
