Hall Building Project: Final Account and Future Plans



This term's meeting of the full Governing Body took place earlier in the week and there are a few items that I would like to share with you. The first of these relates to our recent building project. The governors

have now received the final accounts and I am delighted to inform you that that the project was completed **within** the allocated budget and **on time**. This is a fantastic achievement and I would like to thank the members of our Hall Project Board for the many hours of work they put into leading and managing the project.

The school committed a good chunk of its budget to add to the money provided by the Local Authority, while the village and school communities supported us through many fundraising events. Thanks to the hard work and generosity of a range of individuals, families, groups and organisations, the school has been able to purchase the following items to help kit out the new building:

- New dining tables and benches (and storage trolley)
- Visitors' seating for the hall (and storage trolleys)
- Large interactive screen for the hall
- Stage blocks
- New cloakrooms and storage for Y1/2, Y3/4 and Y5/6
- PE mats and trolley



thanks to everyone involved in this huge fundraising drive!

The new facilities we have in school are making such a difference to the pupils and staff and we should all be very proud that our combined efforts have led to such a wonderful outcome for the school.

Now the building project is complete, staff and governors have reviewed the school's original 'wish list' and have drafted a new programme of improvement to the school building and grounds. This includes the relocation and restocking of the school library, the refurbishment of the old hall, new interactive screens for the EYFS, Year 3/4 and Year 5/6 classrooms and redecoration of other areas of the school. We will need your continued support with fundraising as we work towards achieving the items on the new list and I know the Tilston School Association (TSA) will be targeting the school library in its future fundraising events. Thanks again for your support over the last two years. It's very much appreciated!

Rising 3s and After School Club Charges

In other news from the Governing Body's meeting, a decision was made to phase out provision in the Bluebell Nursery for 'Rising 3s'. This means that **from September 2018**, the nursery will only offer places to pupils in the term **after** they have turned 3. There will also be a small increase to the charges at Early Starters and After School Club to help the school cover staffing costs. **From January 2018**, the cost per session will increase from £3.50 to £3.60. Prices have been fixed in the provision since Early Starters was set up in 2010.

Tilston School Association News: Christmas Fair

It's the time of year where we get ready for the Christmas Fair on 8th December. As usual, the filled jam jars remain ever popular so if you could start saving them now that would be great. School Photographs


