Dear Parents and Carers

As we come to the end of our first week of the new academic year, I would like to say how proud we are of the children. They have all settled in well to their new classes, are happy and working hard. Behaviour across the school is outstanding!

Covid-19 Update

The Covid-19 restrictions were lifted on the 12th August and we continue to follow the Department of Education (DFE) guidance. Please continue to follow Public Health England's guidance to keep our staff, children and families safe.

If you or your child displays any of the three symptoms, you must self-isolate and book a PCR test immediately. Walk-in test centres have a much quicker turnaround for results compared to postal tests.

- 1) A high temperature- this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- 2) A new, continuous cough- this means coughing a lot more than an hour, or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- 3) A loss or change to your sense of taste or smell- this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things taste different to normal.

If your child tests positive- they must self-isolate for 10 days.

If your child's test result is negative- they can return to school if they feel better.

All contact tracing is now carried out by the NHS. Schools are no longer allowed to share information of positive cases in school or inform parents if their child has been in close contact with a child who has tested positive. You will be notified by the NHS if your child is identified as a lose contact.


