Covid-19 Update

Thank you for your support and understanding this week. We are closely monitoring the situation in school. Please continue to wear face masks and social distance to help keep our staff, children and families safe.

We now have 5 confirmed cases across the school.

We are still awaiting the results of PCR tests from some other children.

If you or your child displays any of the three symptoms below, you must selfisolate and book a PCR test immediately. Walk-in test centres have a much quicker turnaround for results compared to postal tests.

- 1) A high temperature- this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- 2) A new, continuous cough- this means coughing a lot more than an hour, or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- 3) A loss or change to your sense of taste or smell- this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things taste different to normal.

If your child tests positive- they must self-isolate for 10 days. **If your child's test result is negative**- they can return to school if they feel better.

Scientific research shows that children can also display the following symptoms which have been consistent with cases in school:

We would advise parents to do daily lateral flow tests if your child displays any of the three additional symptoms.

<u>Lateral flow tests should not be used if your child has one of the main three</u> symptoms.

The Department of Education and Public Health England are monitoring cases in all schools and we complete a daily return. Please email admin@tilston.cheshire.sch.uk with test results so we can update our records. Emails are checked regularly over the weekend if you receive results out of school hours.

Remote Learning

If your child is self-isolating for 10 days due to a Covid-19, teachers will upload the work the children are doing in school on the school website in the Pupil Area. Login details have been sent out this week so everybody can access the work from day 1 of self-isolation. It goes without saying that the most important thing is that your child is safe and well and we only expect children to complete work if they feel well enough. 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
