
* Please note, the cost of a school lunch is now $\pounds 2.30$. Reminder that all children in Reception and KS1 are entitled to a free school meal.

Attendance

As you are aware, we are no longer allowed to authorise any term time holiday. The law does not grant parents an automatic right to take their child out of school during term time. The Department for Education allows a Head Teacher the discretion to consider authorising an absence or holiday in term time <u>only</u> in **exceptional circumstances**. I am currently updating the Attendance Policy in-line with Cheshire West and Chester guidance and will notify you once is it available to view online.

The request for a holiday will remain the same and any holidays, as stated above, will be recorded as unauthorised. It should be noted that if any application is declined and a consecutive five or more unauthorised day's absence occurs, then Tilston Primary may apply to the Local Authority for a Fixed Penalty Notice to be issued to each parent/carer. The penalty is $\pounds 60$ per parent/carer, per child
