Dear Parents and Carers

Covid-19 Update

Thank you for your continued support. I do appreciate how concerning the current Covid situation is in school and in the community and appreciate your support in booking tests and following Public Health advice.

If your child is identified as a contact, I strongly urge parents to book a PCR test at a test centre rather than a postal test where possible please. Results from test centres are received within 24 hours and therefore reduces the risk of children being in school asymptomatic and spreading the virus.

We currently have 3 positive cases in the Wrens class, including a member of staff, and two positive cases in the Kestrels class. I am pleased to inform you that all children and our staff member only have mild symptoms. Please continue to follow all safety measures to keep staff, children and families safe.

Staff are now lateral flow testing daily and booking PCR tests when identified as contacts.

We are following the Department of Education and Public Health guidance. Our current situation is not classed as an outbreak and we hope through regular testing we can reduce the spread of the virus in school. Thank you for working with us, it is very much appreciated.

If you or your child displays any of the three symptoms below, <u>you must self-isolate</u> <u>and book a PCR test immediately</u>. Walk-in test centres have a much quicker turnaround for results compared to postal tests.

- 1) **A high temperature** this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- 2) A new, continuous cough- this means coughing a lot more than an hour, or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- 3) A loss or change to your sense of taste or smell- this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things taste different to normal.
- If your child tests positive- they must self-isolate for 10 days.

If your child's test result is negative- they can return to school if they feel better.
