An increase in prices

From September, there will be a slight increase in prices to the hourly rate for Nursery additional sessions, Early Starters and After School Clubs. We do not provide wrap around care to make a profit, rather than provide a service to support our families. We are keen to continue; however, we need to ensure we are covering our costs. Early Starters will cost £4.00 per session. Nursery additional sessions will cost £4.00 per hour. After School care will cost £4.00 from 3:30-4:30pm and £4.00 for part or all of the final hour; 4:30-5:30pm.

I just want to take this opportunity to thank all the children, parents and staff. I really do feel honoured to have met, known and worked with so many fantastic children.


To the staff, what can I say?! Thank you for being such amazing colleagues and friends!
