IMPORTANT - A new way to book Early Starters and After School Club

We are introducing a new way to book Early Starters and After School Club sessions which will significantly reduce paperwork and administration. For bookings for next half term, you will need to book online using the online payment system. Log on to: www.eduspot.co.uk. Go to the 'Club' section.

Select Early Starters or After School Club and the week(s) you want to book. Using the drop down, select the day/s you want to book. Add them to your basket and pay in the usual way. If you pay with childcare vouchers or through a Government Childcare account, note the amount due for your bookings and arrange your payment. Bookings can be amended up to the day before. Credit will be given for cancelled sessions if more than 24 hours' notice is received. For After School Club, you can select to book up to 4.30pm or 5.30pm. If you book for the first part of the session only and are delayed, a charge for the second part of the session will be added to your account.

Clicking on the 'Help' button will take you to a handy Parent Guide which may help if you are having any problems using the new system. If you can't resolve the issue that way, please contact the school office.

Bookings for next half term will be available to book from Friday 26th November. Places are limited for all sessions so we can maintain our staffing ratios so please book promptly to secure the sessions you need.
