Dear Parents and Carers

Thank you once again for your patience and support as we try to minimise the spread of infection across the school. Public Health have met with school leaders this week to provide an update on the current situation across Cheshire West and Chester as there has been a significant increase in cases over the past two weeks.

We have therefore taken advice from Public Health England and limited the number of people attending each performance, in addition to other safety measures listed below. We cannot issue any additional tickets as we have to adhere to safe occupancy levels per performance, due to health and safety regulations. I do understand that this brings challenges to families with younger siblings but we need to follow advice and guidance to keep our children, staff and families safe. The most important thing is that our shows will go on!

EYFS/KS1- Lights, Camel, Action- Christmas Nativity 2021

Tickets have now been sent home for our Lights, Camel, Action Nativity on Wednesday 8th December at 6pm, Thursday 9th December at 2pm and 6pm. The following safety measures have to be adhered to in order to hold our face to face performances:

- Limited number of places available- only ticket holders will be allowed entry as this enables us to monitor the number of people in the hall.
- Please do a lateral flow test the day of the performance.
- Please wear a face mask at all times.
- Please wrap up as all windows and doors will remain open throughout the performances.
- Parents will be asked to wait on the front yard following the performance and children will be dismissed safely by staff.

We will need all the children to arrive **from 5.30 pm** (no earlier, please) for these evening performances.

These safety measures have been implemented to minimise the risk of infection. Our main priority continues to be the health and safety of our staff, children and families and keeping our school open to all until Friday 17th December 2021.




