This term we would like to invite parents to join us for daily worship. Each class will lead a worship and it would be lovely if you were able to join us. Please see the table below for the dates this term.



Policy Statement

We believe that regular school attendance is important to all children if they are to take full advantage of the educational opportunities available to them.

We actively pursue the goal of regular attendance by investigating all absences, and by positively encouraging parents to understand the importance of regular attendance and urging families to take holidays concurrently with school holidays.

Attendance

<u>Our overall attendance is 96% to date.</u> It is our aim this term to raise attendance across the school. Each week, I will report the attendance in each class. Please work with us and avoid taking holidays during term time.

Lateness

School begins at **8.55 am** and all pupils are expected to be in school for registration at this time. All pupils who are late (Arriving after 8:55am) must report to the office. Where persistent lateness gives cause for concern, the Headteacher will send out a letter inviting parents to meet. The aim of the meeting will be to discuss the reasons for lateness and improve punctuality.

School Procedures for challenging absence

- Every month, Mrs Farmer will produce a report for individual pupil attendance and any pupil falling below 93% will be highlighted.
- Halfway through each term, the Headteacher will send Letter 1 to parents/ carers where a pupil's attendance falls below 93%.
- Where a letter has been sent out, that pupil will be monitored for the next 5 weeks.
- Where there is not an improvement in attendance, Letter 2 will be sent to parents, inviting them into school for a meeting to discuss future attendance targets.

An Attendance Improvement Plan will be set up during the meeting with parents and specific targets set.
