On Saturday 29th January, you will hear the bells at St Mary's in Tilston ringing for about 3 hours from about 10:30 onwards. This is a "peal" that is being rung to celebrate 150 years since Tilston School was opened. It had originally been planned to take place on 15th January but had to be postponed as one of the ringers had Covid.

The group of ringers that are attempting this are members of the oldest Bellringing Society in the Country called the Ancient Society of College Youths which was established in 1637 and are acknowledged to be the premier change ringing society, with members across the world.

The peal that they are attempting is 5040 changes of 41 different arrangements (called Methods) and they are doing this all from memory; this is no mean feat of concentration so sadly you can't go and watch, but you certainly will be able to hear them ringing for our school, and if successful, Tilston School will be in the national peal records as the footnote to the peal event.

We would like to thank St Mary's Church for organising this wonderful celebration in honour of our 150th Anniversary.
