At Tilston Parochial Primary School we aim to provide a high quality, inclusive, broad education that all our children will find interesting, engaging and fun. We use the Early Years Statutory Framework, 2017 and the 2014 National Curriculum as the basis of our planning of all subjects.

A Quick Guide to accessing Home Learning

If your child is self-isolating and well enough to complete schoolwork, please follow the instructions below to access the work the class will be completing this term.

- Please follow the link to open our school website www.tilston.cheshire.ch.uk
- 2) Click on **Classes** and scroll down to your child's class.
- 3) Click on your child's class.
- 4) Scroll down to Files to Download
- 5) Open the **Timetable** document and note the lessons planned each day.
- 6) Open the **Home Learning** document- in **Files to Download** and click on the websites to access activities. The websites have been carefully chosen to enable your child to work on the same objectives as the work children will be completing in school.
- 7) All lessons will be inline with the learning taking place in school.

Our Home Learning Packs are for self-isolating pupils only. In the event of a bubble closing or a national lockdown where teachers are also self-isolating or working from home, we will continue using The Pupil Area on the school website and set daily activities. The Pupil Area is the same system we used previously and there are no changes to login details.
