Dear Parents and Carers

Thank you for your continued support in helping to keep our staff, children and families safe. Could I remind parents to come onto the school yard to collect your child at the end of the day. It is important we keep footpaths clear and make sure children are supervised as they leave the school grounds.



#### **Public Health England**

As cases are increasing across Cheshire West and Chester, Public Health England are working closely with school leaders to ensure clear procedures are in place in the event of a positive case. We have clear policies and procedures in place to ensure we can act immediately. Please see below:

If a child or member of staff tests positive, we would work with Public Health to carry out contact tracing. To identify contacts, we use the following criteria:

- Anyone who has had face to face contact with the person
- Anyone who has been within 1 meter for 1 minute (with or without a face covering)
- Anyone who has been in contact less than 2 meters for 15 minutes or more
- Anyone who has been sneezed or coughed on.

We trace back any of the above contacts within a 72 hour period.

Any 'contacts' identified will be contacted by the school and all contacts will need to self-isolate for 14 days.

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We have robust measures in place to ensure bubbles do not mix, these measures will help to limit the number of children and staff needing to self-isolate and therefore minimising any disruption to learning.

- 1) A text message/email would be sent out to all 'contacts' asap to inform you that your child's bubble is closing with immediate effect.
- 2) A letter will be sent out to parents of children in a specific class/bubble with detailed information from Public Health England. I will follow up this letter with a personal phone call to help to reassure you and answer any questions.
- 3) A letter will be sent out to the whole school informing parents of a positive case in school but with the reassurance that Public Health England and The Department of Education do not feel your child is at a greater risk and is strongly encouraged to attend school.

We will not name staff or children in any correspondence.

# If we receive notification of a positive case, we will close that bubble immediately.

Please consider the added risks when mixing with different households as you could be identified as a contact and need to self-isolate for 14 days.


#### **School Meals**

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
