COVID-19 Update

On Monday, we were informed by Public Health of our first confirmed case in school. I have received several messages from concerned parents regarding the number of children meeting outside school. Schools are open and we are operating in class bubbles. Children, regardless of whether it is with peers in their class bubble, should not be meeting outside of school. The guidance clearly states, 'You must not leave or be outside of your home except for specific purposes.' New National restrictions from 5th November 2020.


Please work with us and follow the lockdown rules to keep our staff, children and families safe.


