Covid Update

We have thankfully been able to keep our staff, children and families safe this term and avoided any disruption to learning in school. I am pleased to report that families who have been affected are safe and well and experiencing mild symptoms. We will continue to follow the strict safety measures in school when we return on Monday 4th January 2021.

It is vital we continue to work together to implement our safety measures to keep staff, children and families safe.

- Please wear a face covering at all times when dropping off and collecting.
- Please arrive at your allocated time. If you arrive early, please wait in your car until your time; this will help to avoid contact with people outside family bubbles.
- Please follow the one-way system- IN through the small gate and OUT via the big gate; this stops face to face contact.
- Please keep a 2 metre distance AT ALL TIMES.
- Please come onto the yard to collect your child and leave the school premises immediately- this is to ensure we minimise contact between adults.
- Please do not stand behind the wall as this blocks the footpath.
- Dogs are not allowed on the school premises.
- Please do not allow children to mix with children in different bubbles on the playground.




Celebration Assembly
