Dear Parents and Carers

I would ordinarily be writing to wish you a happy new year and the hope that you have had a good holiday, and whilst these sentiments remain, I know that the past few days have provided further difficulties and challenges as we are faced with a third national lockdown. I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your support and patience, I am sure you can appreciate the challenges a school closure creates at such short notice. I would like to say a special thank you to our incredible team who have worked tirelessly over the past few days to get the online learning set up and to reopen safely for critical keyworkers. We all feel extremely sad that our wonderful school has closed, but we all appreciate this is the right decision and will help to keep us all safe.

On Wednesday we launched our online learning for all children working from home and I would like to remind parents that this is a legal requirement from the Department of Education. Work will be set daily and we ask that children only use the chat function at the start of the school day.

## **Daily Worship**

I will lead worship every day at 9:15am and focus on our valueperseverance. The waiting room will open approximately 9:05am and children are welcome to use the chat function to share a personal message to their friends. As discussed today, we would encourage all children to behave in the manner that is expected in school. The Zoom meeting room will become our virtual school and our Tilston Code continues to apply to all children.

I have met with our Worship Leaders this week to discuss their feelings since lockdown and to think of ways of developing their roles over the next few weeks to support children in school and at home. We discussed online learning- the highs and the lows. From Monday, we would like all children to wear their school jumpers daily, please feel free to wear leggings, jeans and possibly your slippers!

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We hope this will help children to continue to feel part of our school family, keep to the routine of the school day and will help children to distinguish between home learning and free time at home.

# **Critical Keyworker Childcare**

We have seen significantly high numbers of parents meeting the criteria for critical keyworkers, based on two keyworker families, and unable to care for their children safely at home due to work commitments. We currently have 30% of children in school and cannot offer any more childcare places in accordance with our risk assessment. I do understand the challenges you are experiencing but encourage all parents where possible to follow public health advice and stay at home.
