
Family Worship

Healthbox- Mrs Huxtable

As part of my role as ELSA lead at Tilston Primary School, I am working closely with Healthbox to develop our understanding of mental health and emotional wellbeing across the school. We will be running a 4-week programme for parents called Timid to Tiger. The course aims to explore the role of anxiety within a family, how it develops and how parents/carers are well placed to support children who frequently feel anxious. The sessions will offer practical tips and advice on things that parents can do to help their child cope with their anxiety and overcome challenges they face. The course will be delivered by Lianne Hoyle, Family and Child Mental Health Practitioner.

We would like to invite you to join the workshops, places are limited to a maximum of 15. The sessions will take place at Tilston School in the library.

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Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Stretton Hall Lane (Bridge) in Tilston

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit/restrict traffic on the following length of road in Tilston to enable Bridge repair works to be carried out by Cheshire West And Chester Council. Stretton Hall Lane The Order will come into force on 31st October 2022 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately 12 days to complete. Alternative routes for through traffic Traffic should proceed via Stretton Hall Lane, Barton Road, Broxton Road, Whitchurch Road, Chester Road, Tilston Road, Wet Lane
