Dear Parents and Carers

In Parliament on Wednesday Prime Minister Boris Johnson announced that schools will not return after February half term and that he hopes it will be safe to commence the reopening of schools from Monday 8 March. The government are working closely with unions and scientists to determine a safe date to consider reopening schools for pupils and staff. We are updating our risk assessment to ensure all safety measures are in place.

We all hope that schools will open as soon as possible but we need to remain patient and continue to follow the national lockdown rules. We cannot get this wrong. Children need to come back into school but the wider reopening needs to be sustainable to avoid any further lockdowns and school closures in the future. I will keep you updated and look forward to sharing a date for a wider reopening.

Half Term Holiday

The Department of Education has announced that all schools will close for half term as planned. We will close on Friday 12th February 2021 and will reopen to critical keyworker children on Tuesday 23rd February 2021. There will be no online work set during the holiday. Monday 22nd February is a planned Inset day and all staff will be completing statutory safeguarding training.

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How to scan documents on your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch



Scan a document

- 1. Open Notes and select a note or create a new one.
- 2. Tap the Camera button 🔯, then tap Scan Documents 🗉
- 3. Place your document in view of the camera.
- 4. If your device is in Auto mode, your document will automatically scan. If you need to manually capture a scan, tap the Shutter button or one of the Volume buttons. Then drag the corners to adjust the scan to fit the page, then tap Keep Scan.
- 5. Tap Save or add additional scans to the document.
