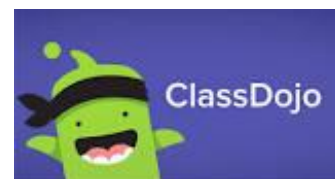

### What's wrong with idling?

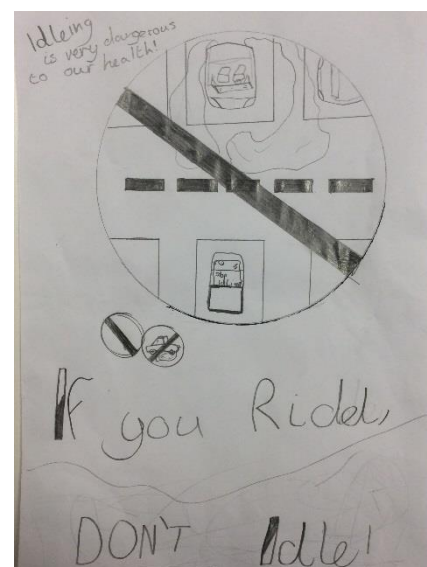
#### What is idling?
